**Footnotes**

BALLYJAMESDUFF, held up off the first flight saving ground in the opening stages, shifted off the rail entering the backstretch, steadily moved to striking distance angling four wide nearing upper stretch, engaged COOL C NOTE for command racing through the stretch and narrowly edged that foe on the wire under right handed pressure following a prolonged drive. COOL C NOTE, caught four deep racing into the first turn while being prompted to gain a contending position, moved to prompt the leaders three deep after a half, attended the pace in that path into the second bend, was roused to challenge for command in that path while between foes into upper stretch and continued in an extended skirmish to the end while just losing the nod. HATTAASH angled inwards while gaining a position just off the pacesetter stalking that foe, moved to press the issue between foes into the second bend, dueled inside the top pair past midstretch but gave out in late stages. HELICOPTER, reserved between foes near the inside in the opening half, shifted out racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final bid. SOUND EFFECT was settled in last to the backstretch, then came around tiring foes racing into the stretch. PROSPECT KNIGHT, caught four wide racing to the backstretch tracking off the second flight, never gained contention. SLAMIT moved to the fore along the inside racing into the first turn, dueled for command inside foes into the far turn and gave way. TABLE GAMES tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening half but came up empty nearing upper stretch. KNIGHT AFTER NIGHT was settled three deep between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch and dropped out early.
