Footnotes

FLY'N LION, reserved out of striking distance racing along the rail to the second bend, saved ground to upper stretch and produced a solid late response nearing the furlong marker to surge clear inside foes under right handed pressure. GREYTAP, caught a bit wide in the opening stages, angled in to track off the second flight between foes, continued with a steady advance between rivals just off the inside racing into upper stretch and edged a rival for second nearing the wire. MURJAN tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight under light rating racing to the second bend, shifted out three deep in upper stretch while being urged to challenge and was just outkicked. HAPMAN, held up avoiding close quarters in the opening stages, continued under reserve along the inside into the second bend, briefly awaited an opening midway through the far turn and made some mild progress inside foes late. E. BLUE hopped at the start, was guided to the rail, continued along the inside to the second bend, swung out seven wide racing into upper stretch and was making some belated progress. FAN TAN MAN, within striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, moved to press the pace inside a rival after a half, set the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend and emptied out racing into upper stretch. SLEW CITY STORM, caught four wide while under reserve off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch and steadily faded from contention. ULTIMATE X., pulling a bit racing three deep just off the second flight in the opening half, lodged a brief, four wide bid midway through the far turn but quickly came up empty. HOOCHED EXPRESS was settled in the last flight racing to the far turn, was fanned eight wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MONT VENTOUX sped to the fore near the inside racing to the backstretch, dueled outside a rival racing into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs. GAELIC STORM, within striking distance three deep in the opening stages, steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
