BEAU HAPPY raced three wide near the middle of the field, rallied in the stretch and was up on the wire. ARSEN ANNIE raced off the rail near the middle of the field, rallied late and lost the nod on the wire. CASHMERE MISS raced inside near the middle of the field and gained belatedly for a share. SARA'S SHADOW set the pace from the inside while pressed and weakened a bit in the drive. ZITLALY raced off the rail near the middle of the field and gained ground in the late going. MS. LYDONIA raced close up inside and made a bid in the stretch, was steadied late and faltered. LIGHTHOUSE LIL lacked speed and improved her position. SARA'S TUNE raced four wide and failed to menace. SAMANTHA B. raced off the rail and gave way. BARREL RACER was always outrun. ECHO JO was also outrun. WISH FOR GOLD pressed the pace from off the rail and tired. (Race run in lane 1, rail at 0.)
