DANCING KRISTAL was allowed to settle then angled out and made a steady advance to be second best. ISLAND MISS rated in the middle of the pack, had a rail trip and closed willingly. SAVY'S DELITE raced in the middle of the pack, made a bid into the stretch but was outfinished. ETERNAL SUNSHINE showed no speed then was shut off and steadied at the top of the stretch and came again late. CALLER A CLASSIC rated in the second flight, made a four wide move into the turn then flattened out. LIGHT SLEEPER showed no speed then angled out and passed tiring rivals. RAINBOW'S SECRET set the pace, led to the stretch then faded. SECRET GLITTER settled along the inside and saved ground then was no factor. ALASKAN TIZZY flashed brief foot then dropped back and was no factor.
