HELLO JAKE settled along the inside, was asked but made no rally. JO'S FINALE raced close up inside, chased the pace then faded. BELLERIVE showed no speed and was no threat. JOEY'S SUPRISE was void of speed and dropped back then was no factor. INTEGRITY'S ECHO showed no speed and was no threat.
