### Footnotes

ST LIAMS HALO was urged to secure a forward placing along the inside racing to the first turn, tracked the leader from easy striking distance to the second bend, shifted outside that foe to wrest command entering upper stretch and was roused clear. NDONGO, settled outside foes in the opening stages, made a steady, three wide advance on the far turn and continued outside foes racing through the stretch to prove best of the others. TEST MARKET, pulling his rider along racing to the first turn, went clear while angling to the inside on the backstretch, dictated the pace under some rating to the far turn but failed to sustain his momentum. FIRST GUESS tracked the leaders along the inside to the far turn, shifted out entering upper stretch but had no final bid. MALIBU VICE was settled along the inside in the opening half, swung out four wide nearing upper stretch and continued willingly. WHERE'S STERLING advanced to gain a tracking position in the second flight racing to the backstretch while outside a rival but came up empty nearing upper stretch. GONDORF, a bit rank under restraint along the inside racing to the first turn, never mounted a serious challenge. STERLING TRUTH settled off the inside in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression. ACHIEVABLE, washy in the post parade, shifted out avoiding GONDORF entering the first turn and dropped out of contention early.
