SHREWD OPERATOR was hustled to secure the lead from inside foes in the opening furlong, gained a clear advantage racing into the turn and steadily widened his margin to the wire while under firm right handed prompting. RIVER BEAR, brushed at the start, was reserved in last while angling to the inside, saved ground on the bend gathering momentum midway through the turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and continued with interest to secure place honors. BIG LOOIE moved to terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo in the opening quarter, couldn't match terms with that foe after three furlongs but finished well enough to save a share. CAPT. BULLET BOB tracked the leaders as part of the second flight while unhurried racing a bit off the inside in the opening stages, angled to the rail entering the turn, made some brief progress inside foes after a half but lacked the needed final response. MIGHTY RULE tracked the leaders five, then four deep as part of the second flight racing to the turn and offered no closing bid. ANGEL TALK settled off the second flight while angling inwards a bit but never gained striking distance. ROYAL EXPRESS led the second flight from within striking distance while three wide racing to the turn but emptied out nearing upper stretch.
