SHEDROW HERO broke outwards bumping ESLA MAMBO, was collected off that foe to gain a tracking position along the rail in the opening quarter, made steady progress saving ground to upper stretch to bid inside the leaders nearing the furlong marker and came through close quarters late to narrowly prevail under brisk right handed prompting. COMITATUS, urged to secure a forward placing, tracked just off the pacesetter near the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside that foe nearing the turn to press the issue racing into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but prevailed for place honors. SHIP FROM ABROAD was hustled to the lead soon after the break, set the pace into the turn, dueled inside a rival while shifting a bit off the rail nearing upper stretch, resisted his challengers to late stages but was narrowly outfinished while between foes. LUCKIEST MAN tracked just off the leaders along the inside, shifted off the inside racing into the bend while making steady progress, angled four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly while closing the gap on the leaders. MCLARD settled off the second flight, angled inwards entering the turn to save ground to upper stretch and made some mild progress in late stages. AZTEC RUN, a bit slow into stride, was settled outside a rival, split foes racing through the turn, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and finished evenly. ESLA MAMBO, bumped at the start, was collected to track in second flight three deep between foes racing into the bend but lacked the needed rally. SEVEN MILE BRIDGE tracked the leaders four wide in second flight racing to the bend but dropped out midway through the turn.
