Footnotes

OUR LADY IN RED, firmly rated racing off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out four wide midway through the bend commencing her advance, continued in that path into upper stretch and produced a sustained response to edge CITYRAP in the final strides under firm left handed encouragement. The latter moved to the fore along the inside soon after the start, dictated the pace on a narrow margin under light rating racing into the turn, shook clear in upper stretch to open a substantial margin and just failed to contain the winner. THIRD CHANCE, close up three wide between foes tracking the leaders under some reserve, made a steady effort in that path between foes racing into the stretch to gain a share. LOVE THIS KITTEN, in close attendance to the pace between foes in the opening stages, lost some position to the leaders after a half, angled inwards racing through the turn, shifted to the rail in upper stretch, then came through tight quarters nearing the furlong marker in an even effort. SEANS SILVERDANCER, prominent four wide in the opening stages, angled inwards after the opening quarter to track just outside the pacesetter racing into the turn but steadily faded after six furlongs. DE LICA settled along the inside from well out of contention, saved ground on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch while gaining some position but made no impression on the leaders. NIKALUK, reserved outside foes in the opening half, was caught four wide racing into the turn and offered no rally. GOLDWAY ducked inwards at the start, was collected, then urged to gain a position inside foes in the second flight in the opening half but emptied out midway through the turn. POINT YOUR FINGER was settled between foes early and offered no rally.
