Footnotes

HYDRO POWER moved clear soon after the break while remaining well off the inside, dictated the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, moved clear of that foe after five furlongs and held sway to the end under steady handling. FORBIDDEN FOREST tracked the leaders near the inside racing as part of the second flight, split foes racing through the turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch and continued well enough to prevail for second. RIVERSHIRE, bumped at the start, settled off the second flight early, advanced to contention racing four wide on the turn but lacked the needed final kick. TABLE GAMES, bumped at the start, was reserved while angling inside, commenced a steady advance inside foes on the turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch, was carried out six wide nearing the furlong marker but continued well in a belated bid. MAVERICKING hopped a bit at the start, was reserved off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out five wide racing through the turn while making some progress but had no final bid. DANCE FOR PACO broke inwards bumping RIVERSHIRE, was guided to the inside, made some brief progress along the rail racing into the bend, was shifted out of close quarters nearing upper stretch while carrying out TABLE GAMES and had no further response. NAGYS PIGGY BANK, held up five deep in the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress three deep racing into the bend but came up empty in the final quarter. NUCKSER led the second flight under light rating a bit off the inside in the opening stages, shifted inside the pacesetter to make a brief bid entering the turn but flattened out after six furlongs. LOST FORTY settled into stride near the inside early and never gained contention. LUMBERYARD JACK tracked the pace between foes racing just off the second flight but steadily faded from contention on the turn. TAPILU, bumped at the start, tracked the leader between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but retreated after five furlongs.
