SPORTS REVIEW stalked the pace while inside then angled off the rail and made a mild bid. SENOR ORTIZ raced close up then ranged up to contend and came up empty late. TB'S CONNECTION showed no speed and passed tiring rivals. STIG'S DEPUTY was rushed to the lead and set the pace then stopped. WHATASHOTZIE raced close up while inside then flashed brief foot and tired. NATIONAL ICON chased the pace early then faded.
