Footnotes

DOUBLEFOUR was reserved in hand from just out of striking distance while angling nearer the inside in the opening half, shifted off the inside gathering momentum entering the far turn, came around foes three deep midway through the second bend to gain striking distance, wrested command in upper stretch and drew clear under firm encouragement. RULEROUS broke inwards, bumped SPARE ME TEN, was righted to dictate the pace along the inside into the backstretch, edged clear nearing upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. LAUGH, in close attendance to the pace three deep in the opening stages, angled in gaining terms with the pacesetter entering the backstretch, pressed that foe entering the far turn, weakened after six furlongs but continued well enough to earn a share. PALO DURO CANYON, close up between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders nearing the backstretch, shifted out three wide after a half, lodged a brief bid in that path entering the far turn but steadily faded once headed by the winner. SPARE ME TEN, bumped at the start, was settled saving ground to the backstretch and never gained contention. SHOW YOUR FACE was settled outside foes racing three deep into the first turn, continued in that path throughout and couldn't produce the needed closing bid. IRON CHAMP broke outwards, was settled between foes in the opening half and never seriously menaced.
