Footnotes

HIGH BROW HONEY, reserved in hand outside foes in the opening stages, commenced a steady, three wide advance entering the turn, shifted out four wide while moving to terms with the first flight in upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker and responded well to just hold the challenge of CAMAGIN under strong handling. The latter, off a step slowly, was reserved along the rail racing off the second flight into the bend, shifted off the inside leaving the midway point of the turn, angled five wide nearing the furlong marker while being roused to challenge and was just outfinished. RAINY RAIN sped clear of her foes from the break, dictated the pace in the opening quarter a bit off the inside, angled to the rail entering the turn, disputed the issue inside foes to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. A SHOT AWAY tracked the pacesetter outside a rival as part of the second flight in the opening stages, steadily advanced on the leaders to press the issue racing three wide on the turn to upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. TATY'S GOLD was guided to the rail early tracking just off the pacesetter under some reserve, was steadied off that foe entering the bend, saved ground tracking the leaders to upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. KNOTTS, forwardly placed from the outset, led the second flight on a narrow margin while shifting off the inside and moving to terms with the pacesetter after the opening quarter, dueled for command between foes into upper stretch and gave way. ALEXANDRIA WA, held up off the second flight outside a rival racing into the bend, couldn't produce the needed closing bid. SWEDISH BEAUTY broke a bit awkwardly and trailed throughout.
