THREEFIFTYSEVENMAG, unhurried leading the second flight from just out of striking distance near the inside in the opening stages, continued with a steady advance to contention racing into the stretch, shifted out three deep leaving the furlong marker and produced a sustained response to wrest command from ROCKSTAR RICHIE and edge forward of that foe in time under firm handling. The latter shifted inwards at the start while moving quickly to the fore, took an awkward step near the seven sixteenths marker, continued to hold sway on a clear margin past midstretch but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. LITTLE KICK was hustled along chasing the pacesetter near the inside from the break, continued in pursuit of the leader saving ground to upper stretch, shifted out racing through the lane but proved no match for the top pair. DANGER STORM broke inwards, was righted to track the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out four wide racing through the stretch and was making mild progress to the end. BUDDYBDANCING, held up out of close quarters at the start, shifted outside foes to race three deep on the bend and continued evenly in that path into the stretch. MACHO COACH tracked the pace from well out of striking distance along the inside, shifted out to split foes nearing upper stretch while continuing in tandem with BUDDYBDANCING but never mounted a serious challenge. WILD GUY shifted to the inside early while tracking off the second flight but steadily faded racing through the turn. WARRIOR'S HIT broke tardily and trailed throughout.
