WABASH MOON secured a contending position in the opening stages tracking the first flight from within striking distance, shifted out leaving the bend to race four wide in upper stretch and continued with a solid late response to collar ANGEL OF MUSIC in time under firm left handed encouragement. The latter was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, held sway on a clear margin past the furlong marker but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. SARAH MELISSA steadily moved to contention between foes while angling inwards a bit in the opening quarter, tracked just off the pacesetter racing through the bend, but couldn't match the top pair racing through the stretch while clearly best of the others. NOT REPENTFUL settled along the inside in the opening stages, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position three deep between foes. PRETTY HEIRESS broke sharply, stalked the pacesetter outside a rival racing three deep into the bend but gave way nearing midstretch. HORSCHHE, held up out of close quarters at the start, tracked outside foes racing into the bend while racing out of striking distance and offered no rally. HOLY POW WOW settled between foes in the opening stages, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. FEELS GOOD tracked the leaders along the rail from just out of striking distance, saved ground to upper stretch and steadily faded in late stages. TADAAWI broke outwards, was settled between foes in the opening stages but soon dropped out of contention.
