FREEDOM LADY broke slowly, had a wide trip and a late rally but not good enough. MARGRET S. had no speed then rallied inside late. FROSTY DEBUT set a pressured pace then gave way grudgingly. MY MAAT was void of early speed and passed tiring rivals. MZ FUZZ went evenly and had no rally. PLAYMONEY'S DREAM was through early and failed to menace. KERRY FROST TOO had no speed and was always outrun. BELLE OF THE CUBS stalked the pace off the rail then stopped between horses late. DIXIELAND LEAL broke awkwardly and trailed.
