MULATA, reserved along the inside in the opening half, came around a tiring foe entering the far turn to make a steady advance to contention, shifted three wide entering upper stretch to challenge, then edged AIN'T NO SAINT in the final stages under firm encouragement. The latter, unhurried tracking just off the first flight in the opening stages. led the second flight into the far turn, moved to challenge the pacesetter splitting foes entering upper stretch, gained the lead near midstretch but proved no match for the winner. LIGHTHOUSE DANCER was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace into the far turn but weakened when failing to match terms with the top pair. UNDER THE RIM angled inwards to gain terms with a rival on the lead, stalked that foe to the far turn, made a brief bid racing through the second bend but steadily faded entering upper stretch. MONASHEE ROSE, caught four wide in the opening stages, raced in tandem with a rival in second flight to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. JO'S FINALE tracked the pace between foes in second flight to the backstretch but soon emptied out entering the far turn.
