KING DAVID was urged to gain a position inside a rival in the second flight tracking the pacesetter under light reserve racing to the backstretch, continued along the rail into upper stretch, shifted out nearing the furlong marker to split foes challenging for command and wrested command in time under firm right handed encouragement. DANCING ROCK was hustled clear while angling inwards racing into the first turn, set the pace along the inside on a narrow margin racing into the second bend, resisted the winner's challenge to the end but came up second best. PRYCE'S POSSE shifted in to track just off the pacesetter outside a rival as part of the second flight in the opening half, advanced on the leader to prompt that foe on the far turn but lacked the needed final kick while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. TENSAW angled inwards to track off the second flight between foes under rating in the opening half, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. H T H THIRTYSEVEN worked his way to the inside racing well out of striking distance in the opening stages, but came around some tiring foes near the inside to improve his position racing into the stretch. PETAK MOUNTAIN, reserved along the inside as part of the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering upper stretch, raced in hand when caught in some traffic leaving the three sixteenths marker but continued willingly to the end. SHINE THE ROCKET hopped at the start brushing the gate, was settled well off the second flight, raced four wide into the far turn and made no impression on the leaders. BOSS ALLEY, a bit slow into stride, made some progress

racing four, then three deep entering the far turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. CURZON STREET tracked off the second flight under light reserve along the rail racing to the far turn but steadily retreated racing into upper stretch. WASN'T ME was settled outside a rival in the last flight for five furlongs, was caught wide racing through the far turn and offered no rally. DEPEND tracked off the second flight three deep in the opening half but dropped out of contention early.
