Footnotes

SARA'S CAPE, reserved out of tight quarters at the start, raced unhurried three deep from out of striking distance in the opening half, made steady progress in that path on the far turn drawing into striking distance, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and just edged BREWMISTRESS in the final stages under firm encouragement. The latter, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being urged to challenge, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker, resisted the winner's bid but lost the advantage nearing the wire. BELLA SERENADE, reserved between foes off the second flight racing to the far turn, made steady progress racing into the stretch to split foes three deep while advancing in some traffic to challenge for command between foes but was outkicked by the top pair. MARKET BUZZ settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the backstretch, swung out five wide nearing upper stretch and made some belated progress to close the gap. KITCHEN BOSS, a bit slow into stride, shifted to the inside early, switched out entering upper stretch to split foes three deep, then came through some close quarters in late stages while continuing willingly between foes to gain position to the end. DANI NIKKI hopped at the start, was reserved along the inside to the backstretch, shifted outside foes nearing the far turn, was caught four wide racing through the far turn, continued in that path between foes into upper stretch and lacked the needed final momentum while racing in some close quarters late. BELLAMAYA, forwardly placed along the inside tracking just off the leader, came through along the rail to challenge entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. LOVE THY NEIGHBOR bobbled at the break, was rank between foes racing to the backstretch, shifted outside the pacesetter on the backstretch to press that foe racing into the far turn, exchanged some contact with the leader entering

upper stretch and quickly emptied out in the drive. ENGLISH ACCENT tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the far turn and came up empty nearing upper stretch. MISSION STORM, reserved off the second flight racing to the backstretch, never mounted a serious challenge. PRANKSTERBDANCING sped to the fore outside foes racing into the first turn, set the pace along the inside to the second bend, shifted out exchanging some contact with LOVE THY NEIGHBOR in upper stretch and quickly gave out. PUSHIN UP DAISY, pulling a bit while shifting out to race between foes into the backstretch, retreated from contention early.
