DOUBLE SILVER dueled, lost the lead briefly then came again inside gamely to best MANITO. MANITO dueled, took the lead in the stretch but weakened late in the long drive. APACHE SUNRISE as unhurried early, made a bid while wide in the turn but was no match for the top two. RUM CUSTOMER had no speed and some late run five wide. TOUGH JODI was bumped at the start, stalked the pace off the rail and dropped back. PATH OF HONOR was bumped start, flashed brief foot inside and gave way. INDY'S SPELL was bumped and shuffled back at the start and no factor. SOMETHING GAINED was through early and not involved.
