Footnotes

BEFORE YOU KNOW IT tracked the pacesetter from just out of striking distance racing three deep in the opening stages, made steady progress in that path to challenge for command nearing midstretch, wrested the advantage in the closing stages and went clear under firm left handed pressure. ZENCAT settled off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, switched outside foes racing into upper stretch but continued with a steady late response to prevail for place honors. BETTERLEGSONATABLE was urged to the lead along the inside soon after the break, set the pace on a clear margin racing into the turn, held sway into upper stretch but failed to sustain that momentum once challenged by the winner. LADY DOZER tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the bend and continued evenly to late stages. FLYING RAPUNZEL shifted off the inside early while being urged to prompt the pacesetter racing into the bend but steadily faded along the inside racing into the stretch. BOURBONSTREETGIRL settled into stride off the inside, was caught four wide racing into the turn and offered no rally. MURU MURU was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but retreated from contention early.
