GO GO FRITZY was settled off and outside the second flight in the opening quarter, made a steady, three wide advance to contention racing into upper stretch and continued with a solid late response to wrest command and kick clear under pressure. SWEET CHARISE, held up avoiding tight quarters early, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch but made a steady late bid to gain the place honors. BOLD STREET CAT, steadied along the rail in early stages, shifted out on the turn to split foes racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position between foes while earning a share. YOUR MOVE sprinted clear of her foes while angling to the inside, set the pace on a clear margin to midstretch but faltered leaving the furlong marker. MY DEAR DESERT, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside the pacesetter pursuing that rival into the bend, moved to close the gap nearing midstretch but weakened between foes leaving the furlong marker. POLAR QUEEN angled to the inside early tracking the leaders as part of the second flight, saved ground on the bend and lacked a closing response. ROMAFLAME was a brief factor outside foes in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded after a half. TRUE NIGHTMARE, caught four wide racing into the turn, never gained contention. RETOUR settled into stride near the inside, saved ground into upper stretch and proved no threat. MYHONEYELOPEDAGAIN was a brief factor between foes in the second flight, shifted to the inside nearing the turn and gave way abruptly racing into upper stretch.
