RESPONSIVE EYE was rated just out of striking distance tracking the first flight outside a rival in the opening half, responded with a sweeping five wide run on the far turn when given his cue to circle foes gaining command racing into upper stretch and drew away in late stages under pressure. SCOT'S SUNNYRIVER sprinted to the lead outside foes in the opening sixteenth, then angled to the rail once clear setting the pace into the backstretch, duled for command inside foes maintaining a narrow advantage racing into the second bend, couldn't contain the winner's bid but edged clear of the remaining field racing through the stretch to prove clearly second best. HOMES THE FACT, forwardly placed between foes under some prompting to contend early, was urged to press the issue between foes racing into the far turn but weakened into the stretch when failing to match the top pair. CAPTAIN AMERICAN settled into stride along the inside dropping well out of striking distance in the opening stages, gathered some momentum while swinging out five wide entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. SGT. MAJOR ROSS, caught four wide racing into the backstretch while being prompted to maintain contention, lodged a brief bid between foes in that path racing into the second bend but quickly flattened out. RIO CHAMA stumbled at the start, was righted to track off the first flight along the inside racing into the far turn but had no closing bid. LEAL RIDGE settled outside a rival in the last flight early and never subsequently menaced. WEALTH MANAGEMENT was a brief factor three wide between foes prompting the pace into the backstretch but steadily retreated racing through the far turn.
