STAKES Arlington Classic S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each horse (Early) March 13,2002, \$500 each horse (Late Nomination) on June 5,2002. Fee to accompany the nomination. Original nominees to pay \$1,750 to pass the entry box and \$1,750 additional to start.

WEIGHT: 126 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 twice at one mile or over in 2002, allowed 3 lbs.; \$55,000 twice at one mile or over in 2002, 5 lbs.; \$55,000 once at a mile or over in 2002, 7 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over anytime, 10 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) This event will be limited to fourteen starters,(7 Non-North American starters and 7 North American starters.)

Preference will be given in the following order: (1st) (A) Grade/Group I Turf winners in 2002-(B) Grade/Group I winners winners on Dirt; (2nd) (A) Grade/Group II Turf winners in 2002 -(B)Grade/Group II winners of Dirt; (3rd) (A) Grade/Group III Turf winners in 2002-(B) Grade/Group III winners on Dirt. Footnotes

MR. MELLON was allowed to settle inside near the middle of the field, moved up on the final turn, angled out in the stretch, split rivals late and rallied to be up in the final strides. DOC HOLIDAY (IRE) was reluctant to load into the gate, pressed the pace from just outside, rallied to a short lead in the stretch and just failed to hold off the winner. SEAINSKY was void of early speed while away from the rail, angled out in the stretch and finished well in the middle of the course. JEREMIAH JACK established good position along the inside while not far back, angled out for room in the stretch and failed to respond when asked for his best. ROBIN ZEE lacked speed, moved up along the inside and loomed a threat in the stretch but came up empty in the final furlong. CAPPUCHINO quickly sprinted clear and dropped to the rail, set the pace to the stretch then weakened in the closing yards. STONEMASON raced just outside near the middle of the field but never reached a contending position. FEBRUARY STORM raced close up three wide and tired. SCOOTER ROACH raced three wide and was through after a half.
