MISS BOCEPHUS raced off the rail near the middle of the field and lacked a rally. WHERE'S MY PURSE vied for the lead inside and tired. SHES GOOD TO GO made a bid on the turn and faltered. QUEEN STELL raced inside but was through early. GLITTERING SEAS had speed off the rail and gave way.
