**Footnotes**

FLY UNITEDLY was settled into stride well off the second flight while being guided nearer the inside in the opening stages, saved ground racing into the bend, shifted out near the three sixteenths marker to split foes four wide and produced a solid late response to wrest command from PRETTY PERCEPTIVE in the final stages, pulling clear under firm left handed prompting. The latter shifted out at the start, secured a position in the second flight just off the inside while under some reserve, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch while moving to striking position, took over leaving the furlong marker to gain a clear advantage between calls late but proved no match when confronted by the winner. OODLES, held up a bit when racing in some close quarters just after the start, tracked the leaders along the inside racing into the turn, switched off the inside entering upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to improve her placing and gain a share. HELLO HANNAH was urged to the fore while shifting well off the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command outside a rival into upper stretch and weakened in late stages when failing to contain the top pair. KANIJA tracked the pace unhurried between foes racing off the second flight in the opening stages and continued evenly three deep into the stretch. BOSS GIRL was urged to secure a forward placing inside foes, moved to dispute the lead inside a rival racing into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. EAST OF OMAHA gained a position outside foes racing five wide in second flight in the opening quarter but steadily faded from contention after a half. UNREGULATED was a brief factor three wide between foes in the second flight but retreated from contention entering the turn. DILLINGHAM was settled outside foes in the opening stages and proved no factor.
