### Footnotes

LAMBORGENIE was prompted to secure a forward placing tracking just off the leaders near the inside, steadily moved to terms with the pacesetter after a half to assume command midway through the turn, turned back a challenge from MISS POLLIPOPOP nearing upper stretch, opened a commanding margin midstretch and continued resolutely to hold safe NOBLE GRACE under firm encouragement. The latter, held up three deep behind the second flight in the opening stages, steadily drew into striking distance in the second quarter, angled to the rail entering upper stretch commencing her bid, moved to challenge inside the winner racing through the stretch and was going well late. WILD STORY, reserved off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out racing through the turn while steadily improving her position racing three deep into the stretch. MISS POLLIPOPOP tracked the leaders, five, then four deep in second flight in the opening quarter, advanced to challenge three deep after a half but flattened out nearing upper stretch when failing to match terms with the winner. BABY NAVY, reserved while being guided to the inside in the opening stages, gained some position inside foes on the turn while continuing evenly racing into the stretch. LITTLE WHITE STAR, held up outside a rival in the opening stages, continued in tandem with a rival splitting foes racing through the turn but never gained striking distance. WEIGHTY SITUATION was urged to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace into the turn and gave way after five furlongs. FIRMLAND tracked the leaders unhurried between foes off the second flight racing to the turn but offered

no closing bid. NICKYSGREATCAUSE broke sharply, tracked just outside the pacesetter in the opening quarter but was spent early.
