Footnotes

ZIPPING AWAY, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter three deep between foes in the opening stages, angled nearer the inside midway through the backstretch to track just off the first flight outside a rival, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, split foes three deep when presented an opening entering upper stretch to challenge and narrowly prevailed in the closing stages under firm handling. WINNING STAR, unhurried between foes in the opening stages, worked her way to the rail to gain a position just off the first flight entering the backstretch, made steady progress along the inside racing through the far turn to challenge for command nearing upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage nearing the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the winner.

KEEP ON SINGING broke outwards making contact with HARROW HILL, settled into stride along the inside, made steady progress racing into the far turn to bid for command between foes entering upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. CHICKABUNNY, unhurried near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out advancing between foes on the far turn, bid four deep racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. HARROW HILL, bumped at the start, was reserved in the opening half, saved ground on the far turn and made steady progress into the stretch to improve her position inside foes. GIVERNY GIRL, reserved along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out leaving the far turn and made an effort to improve position between foes racing through the stretch. COUGAR CRUISE, caught four wide racing into the first turn while under some prompting to gain a forward placing, moved to challenge three deep racing into the far turn, drifted out leaving the midway point of the second bend, quickly gave way and was forced out wider into the stretch by SAM'S PHILLY in late stages. LIGHT MY SAPHIRE broke slowly, settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. SAM'S PHILLY was hustled to the lead while angling to the inside racing into the first turn, dueled for command into the far turn, drifted out after six furlongs and quickly gave way. COURTESY CALL was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. SUSPENDED MOON, urged to secure a forward placing between foes racing to the backstretch, pressed the pacesetter between foes racing into the far turn and emptied out abruptly after six furlongs. LITTLE WICKED, caught five wide while being urged to a contending position racing into the first turn was spent after a half.
