Footnotes

WILDCAT MISS, off a step behind the leaders, tracked the pace from just out of striking distance along the rail racing into the bend, came under pressure midway through the bend to advance, steadily gained position entering upper stretch, shifted out three deep nearing the sixteenth marker and took over late under firm encouragement. HELLO HANNAH broke readily to gain terms with the first flight, attended the pace three deep racing into the turn, was urged to press the issue outside a rival nearing upper stretch to gain the advantage approaching the furlong marker but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. SLAVIC PRINCESS was urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the break, dueled for command to midstretch but yielded to the top pair late. SHESMORETHANATIGER broke a step slowly, settled into stride outside rivals racing to the turn, came through close quarters splitting foes three deep nearing upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while just missing for a share. SPRINGTIME SPELL tracked off and outside the first flight racing four wide into the turn, continued widest into the stretch and had no closing bid. ALLABOUTIMAGE (NZ), prominent between foes in the opening stages disputing the pace, gave way nearing upper stretch.
