SOUND WAVE raced close up inside, rallied to the front in the stretch and was not menaced late while drawing off. SOMETHING WICKED lacked speed, started a rally outside on the turn, entered the stretch five wide and rallied for the place while no match for the winner. LADY SKY RACER stalked the leaders but lacked a winning bid and lost the place late. LOWER EAST SIDE lacked speed then gained belatedly. COTTAGE ROSE was void of early speed and steadily improved her position. QUEEN LAURA JEAN set the pace and was clear on the turn but tired. SOUTH OCEAN ACT saved ground but was never a factor. RIEPE RIDGE lacked speed and showed little. CRUZIN TO THE HOOP raced off the rail and was outrun. SAWREE was also outrun. LEAPTOTHEDEFENSE raced close up off the rail but tired. NICKEL BEAUTY gave way after a half. RACE CONTESTED IN LANE 2. RAIL AT 6 FEET.
