CHINDI was void of speed, angled out for the drive, finished fast and did not miss by much. SILVER ZIPPER was never a factor. TIC N TIN pressed the pace from the inside and weakened. SPECTACULAR CAT was through early. PROVEN CURE raced close up outside and tired. MINERS GAMBLE was always outrun.
