HAIL VICTORY raced close up inside, took a clear lead in the stretch and just failed to last. MICKEY THE MUSE lacked speed off the rail and moved up in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. FORT FLASH lacked speed and improved his position. ALBY also improved his position without threatening. BERNEL TRAIL raced close up off the rail, gave way and was vanned off. DISTORTED GROOM gave way after a half. WYOMING FRANK set the pace from off the rail and tired. TAX EXEMPTION gave way in the drive.
