QUEEN OF THE NILE was guided to the inside early taking up a position racing just out of striking distance, commenced a steady advance along the rail nearing upper stretch, bid for command inside the leaders nearing the furlong marker and just edged those foes under steady handling. NOYOUCAN'T was held up off the first flight in the opening half, advanced to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, continued to dispute the issue in that path to late stages and was just outfinished. ANEWPAIROFSHOES gained terms with a rival on the pace along the inside in the opening stages while attending the tempo under light rating, pressed the issue on the turn, continued willingly between foes through the stretch and was just outkicked. BEYYA broke readily to dictate the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed the pace racing into the turn and gave way in upper stretch. TRIBUTE TO MOMMA settled into stride along the inside racing well off the leaders, angled out five wide in upper stretch but made no impression. BROOKE'S JOURNEY settled outside a rival in the last flight early and dropped out racing into upper stretch.
