FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination. A Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 may be made on Saturday, June 23, 2012, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHTS: Sunday, June 24, 2012. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Highweights preferred. Total earnings in 2012 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Wednesday, June 20, 2012 with 17.

**Footnotes**

KITTY IN A TIZZY was urged to secure a position inside foes in the second flight tracking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance racing through the backstretch, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch and produced a steady closing response to wrest command in late stages under firm handling. MAUDE S was guided to the rail in early stages while settling well off the leaders, commenced a steady advance inside foes racing on the rail through the turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and was making solid progress late while gaining the place honors. ARIANA D tracked the pace unhurried racing well off the second flight while outside a rival racing to the turn, advanced to contention four deep on the bend, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and found her best stride late to prevail for a share. HONEY CHILE sped clear of the field while shifting to the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum past the furlong marker. LADY CHESTERFIELD was rated three deep in the second flight tracking the pacesetter, continued with a steady bid nearing upper stretch to challenge the leader between foes but lacked the needed final response. HEMERA, bumped by LUNAR MIST and taken up at the start, never gained contention. DONTBESHY I'LL BUY was a brief factor between foes in the second flight racing through the backstretch but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. LUNAR MIST broke inwards bumping HEMERA, was righted to gain a position just off the second flight racing to the turn but emptied out nearing upper stretch.
