Footnotes

ESOTERIC was reserved off the second flight saving ground to the backstretch, shifted out after a half gathering momentum, circled foes four wide to wrest a clear advantage entering upper stretch and drew away under pressure. RUNAWAY CAL, rated just off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out racing through the far turn to bid three deep between foes, couldn't match the winner but proved best of the others. CLASSIC RECITAL, forced out at the start, was settled into stride three deep tracking well off the second flight, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. MI LUNA GRANDE bobbled at the start, settled in last near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn, was fanned six wide entering the stretch but made some belated progress. OH MY TODD swerved out at the start crossing the path of CLASSIC RECITAL, was urged to contention four deep racing into the first turn, was eased off the leaders to track those foes outside a rival in second flight to the far turn, made a brief bid three deep between foes nearing upper stretch but proved empty in the drive. SCAPPARE settled well off the pace near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out five wide leaving the far turn while being urged to advance between foes but lacked the needed final bid. LA SWIFT broke awkwardly, settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch but never gained contention. SIR KIPLING settled between foes off the second flight early was shuffled in

traffic racing through the far turn and never mounted a serious challenge. BARANIT, within striking distance three deep between foes in the opening stages, was guided to the inside nearing the backstretch to track the pace in second flight, shifted out on the far turn to make a brief bid between foes, then was steadied in close quarters nearing the quarter mile marker while quickly losing all momentum. B. MONSOUR was urged to the lead along the inside from the outset, set the pace on a narrow margin racing into the far turn and emptied out abruptly after six furlongs. PIECEOFTHEACTION was urged to force the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch and gave way after a half.
