MY PRIVILEGED saved ground and moved up in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. BACHICHO also failed to rally. SAN SABA set the pace from the inside and tired. JUDGE COLOMBO lacked speed and was not a factor. COUNT ON IT pressed the pace off the rail and gave way. HAUTAIN was three wide and was through early. RACE RUN IN LANE 1, RAIL IN 10 FEET.
