BLOND WARRIOR moved to the fore outside foes to wrest command in the opening furlong, angled to the inside to dictate the pace on a comfortable margin racing through the turn, then forged clear in upper stretch, extending her margin to the end under steady pressure. BEYYA, close up between foes from the break, angled to the rail tracking just off the first flight, came around a tiring foe to advance inside rivals nearing upper stretch and proved best of the others. WERBLIN'S CHANCE, prominent between foes from the outset, chased the pacesetter into upper stretch and weakened in the final quarter. OUTBREAK hesitated at the start, settled into stride along the inside, shifted outside racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring foes. MARKREE BREEZE was a brief factor chasing the pacesetter three deep racing into the turn but gave way entering upper stretch. LADY LUA broke slowly, lost position to the field and never menaced thereafter. MELOVEDA was a brief factor between foes but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. RICHIE'S STAR ducked inwards at the start, was quickly righted to briefly dispute the pace along the rail but was spent after the opening quarter.
