Footnotes

SANTA moved readily to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn, was roused to turn back several challengers racing through the stretch and gamely held the challenge of MR. MISCHIEF to the end. The latter, held up outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued under some reserve while losing some position entering the far turn, split foes three deep leaving the far turn to challenge four wide in upper stretch and closed the gap while just losing the nod. I AM THE SHERIFF, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and was going well late to close the gap and gain a share. ALBIN tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, advanced three deep between foes after a half to challenge the pacesetter racing into upper stretch but weakened in late stages. CHARGING HOME bobbled a bit at the break, was pulling his way along racing inside a rival in the second flight into the backstretch, was urged to challenge inside the winner nearing midstretch when presented an opening but was taken in hand when shut off by that foe in late stages. QUIETDETERMINATION, unhurried along the inside, was held up out of close quarters racing through the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. GOLD FORMER, reserved between foes tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out of close quarters to race five wide into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. BALLYJAMESDUFF, reserved off the inside racing to the backstretch, never gained contention. OLD HICKORY was steadied a bit racing along the rail tracking off the second flight in the opening stages and retreated from contention early. LIONDRIVE raced outside foes off

the second flight in the opening stages, made some progress midway through the backstretch to advance four wide racing into the far turn but quickly emptied out. HIGH HEIR angled inwards while briefly tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch but steadily retreated entering the far turn.
