Footnotes

ABBY'S SLEW was held up off the pace while outside the leaders in the opening stages, angled in before a half, moved steadily to terms with the pacesetter between foes nearing upper stretch, wrested command while shifting to the inside in upper stretch and gamely held BLOOMING FLOWER to the end under firm handling. The latter settled between foes in the last flight early, was urged to advance splitting rivals just off the inside racing into upper stretch, drew even with the winner in the final stages but couldn't best that foe. SILVER ENCORE, reserved outside foes in the last flight racing to the bend, continued three deep to upper stretch and finished well enough to prevail for a share. BOBBIE N HER GIRLS was rated tracking just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, advanced in tandem with the eventual winner to lodge a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. MONA MONA was settled along the inside in the opening stages, then urged to gain contention inside foes racing into the turn but soon came up empty. IRON ROSE moved clear while shifting to the inside, set the pace on a clear margin racing into the turn and emptied out once headed by the winner.
