ORIENTATE EXPRESS sped clear of his foes soon after the break, dictated the pace on his own courage along the inside racing into the turn and maintained a clear advantage to the end under steady encouragement. SWORD AND SHIELD tracked just off the leaders near the inside under light rating early, continued with a steady bid to challenge in tandem with a rival nearing upper stretch, couldn't gain even terms with the winner but proved best of the others. LEMON CUSTARD settled in last while working his way to the rail in the opening stages, saved ground on the bend, shifted off the inside in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid to narrowly prevail for a share three deep between foes. CALL TO GLORY shifted outside the pacesetter while taking up a stalking position, moved to briefly challenge the leader three deep nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort through the final three sixteenths. UNBRIDLED VICAR settled just out of striking distance racing outside a rival in the opening half, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and finished evenly late.
