Footnotes

RAINBOW BLOSSOM, prominent along the inside from the outset, ceded the lead to a rival racing into the first turn while shifting outside that foe, continued on terms with the pacesetter attending the pace racing into the second bend, was urged to press the issue nearing upper stretch and edged forward in late stages under firm encouragement. VINDICED GYPSY moved to the fore while shifting to the inside to set a comfortable pace on a narrow margin racing to the far turn, resisted the winner's bid to late stages but came up second best. AWALKINTHEMOONLITE, reserved off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch, switched out to advance five wide entering upper stretch and continued with a steady bid to close well on the leaders while edging a rival for a share. SECRET STORY (IRE) was settled in last racing to the far turn, swung six wide in upper stretch and was making steady progress late. NIKALUK tracked the leaders from just out of striking position inside a rival racing to the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch while being roused to advance but finished evenly in late stages while caught in some close quarters nearing the wire. HERE OUI GO AGAIN worked her way to the inside gaining a position just off the second flight, came through inside foes when presented an opening entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while racing in some close quarters. CASS' LADY, reserved three deep behind the second flight in the opening half, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch while making an effort to gain some position but made little impression on the leaders. OVERTIME BELLE tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. HARBOR SPIRIT, reserved along the inside racing well out of striking distance early, never mounted a serious challenge.
