Footnotes

PIRATESINPARADISE was urged to secure the lead while angling to the rail racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin racing to the second bend, then extended his advantage under pressure racing through the stretch. RYAN'S REX tracked the pacesetter within striking distance outside a rival racing to the far turn, couldn't match terms with the leader entering upper stretch but proved best of the others. IVER WITH AN E, reserved along the inside in the opening half, shifted out entering the far turn to split foes four wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to narrowly prevail for a share. EIGHT GAUGE shifted out racing to the backstretch to track outside foes behind the second flight, made steady progress to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, then continued willingly between foes in that path to the end while just missing for a share. TENS WILD settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, shifted out five deep racing through the far turn but made steady progress in that path to late stages while being outfinished for a share. SHELLYS WILD angled inside tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing to the far turn but came up empty in the drive. ROYAL CANDIDATE tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the second bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. WALK THE WALK tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening half and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. CAPTAIN AMERICAN was settled between foes early and never seriously menaced.
