BOOTS ARE WALKING stalked the pace the made a five wide rally to get up in the final strides. ROCK CHALK raced close up along the inside then was set down for the long drive but was outfinished. Z'BULLSEYE broke sharply and set the pace and gave way late. MCMURPHY settled early then rallied between horses and took up then was full of run. MADDY'S BOBCAT was allowed to settle then ranged up while five wide and made a mild rally. COCKADOODLE got off slowly and moved while six wide then passed tiring rivals. WHO LET THE CAT IN showed no speed and saved ground then made no rally. RABBONI showed no speed and was no factor. PREDESTINATION stalked the pace between horses and tired in the stretch.
