Footnotes

GOLDPOINT vied for command along the rail from the break, continued willingly in a prolonged duel inside OWEN THE TIGER into upper stretch, then edged forward in late stages under brisk handling. The latter attended the pace under some reserve outside foes in the opening quarter, moved to press the issue three deep racing through the turn, continued in an extended skirmish past midstretch but weakened when failing to match terms with the winner. SOUTHERN MUDD hopped a bit at the start, was quickly righted to track the leaders from out of striking distance along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch and made some late progress to improve his position. DEB'S CONTE tracked just off the first flight near the inside racing to the turn, shifted four wide after a half to challenge but soon flattened out. WINDY CITY LEAL broke inwards bumping a rival, was settled between foes in the opening stages, split foes three deep racing into upper stretch but never gained contention. LETDETRUMPETBLARE broke in the air, was bumped by WINDY CITY LEAL at the start, settled out of striking distance, then passed inside tiring rivals in the final furlong while proving no menace. SUCHAFOOL, reserved in hand outside foes in the opening quarter, raced four wide throughout and never seriously menaced. ROSEMONT SAMMY was urged to dispute the pace between foes racing to the bend and emptied out after a half.
