Footnotes

PULLMANITE took up a tracking position outside a rival in the opening half while unhurried racing out of striking distance early, made steady progress three deep entering the bend to gain terms with the first flight, bid for command in that path approaching the furlong marker, then wrested command and went clear under strong handling. FIRE CLOUD rated out of striking distance near the inside in the opening stages, saved ground while advancing in tandem with several foes to draw into striking distance entering upper stretch, shifted outside some tiring foes to race four wide past the furlong marker but continued well enough to edge a rival for the place. SHELTOWEE was settled in hand in the opening half, swung six wide entering stretch, then made some belated progress to gain a share. TERRIFIC TIM prompted the pace outside a rival soon after the start, dueled with that foe into upper stretch and gave way. BUD SYMONDS was settled along the inside early, gradually moved into contention entering upper stretch, then angled out five wide in midstretch to make a mild bid between foes. ENGINE ROOM was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the break, dueled inside that foe into upper stretch and gave way. SORREL OF THE SEA threw his head at the start, raced in tandem with the leaders in the opening furlong, stalked just off those foes in hand racing to the bend, made a brief bid between foes midway through the turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. BATTLE POWER, caught widest early, never gained contention.
