STOP A TRAIN raced close up off the rail, rallied in deep stretch and was along in the last. LA JOYERIA raced close up off the rail, rallied to a clear lead in the stretch and just failed to last. GENDER NAVY raced off the rail near the middle of the field and rallied belatedly for a share. DOBSON saved ground near the middle of the field and made a bid but flattened out. NOW was bumped at the start, lacked speed and improved her position. GLAMOUR'D lacked speed off the rail and also improved her position without threatening. FRONT PAIGE GAL raced close up inside and gave way. HIGH CHANT was checked into the first turn, raced four wide, came five wide into the stretch and failed to reach contention. BADABOOM set the pace from the inside and tired. SCARLET CHILD raced close up off the rail and gave way. ALLIE MCGOOF was always outrun. (Race run in lane 5, rail out 14 feet.).
