Footnotes

PLAYING A JOKE a bit outpaced in the opening stages, gradually advanced to contention along rail on the bend, shifted out in upper stretch, then came through close quarters near the inside to split foes leaving the furlong marker, wrested command in the final sixteenth and went clear under firm handling. MENTIROSO, bumped and forced into the path of TRENCHANCY at the start, was quickly righted to chase the leaders three deep into the bend, was bumped by TANK'S LETTER while being forced out four wide in upper stretch but continued with interest to earn a share. DR SWIFT was urged to dispute the pace along the inside from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened late. TANK'S LETTER stumbled at the break bumping GIBBY'S TORNADO, was righted to chase the leaders along the inside, shifted out into the path of MENTIROSO in upper stretch bumping that foe and lost his momentum in late stages. GIBBY'S TORNADO, bumped at the start, quickly recovered to force the pace outside a foe into upper stretch and weakened late. RUN BIG BUD RUN angled to the inside tracking the pace but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. TRENCHANCY, bumped at the start, never gained contention. TUXEDO REQUIRED broke outwards bumping MENTIROSO and soon dropped out.
