Footnotes

DOUBLE JUMP tracked the pace unhurried outside foes in the opening stages, advanced in tandem with a rival racing three deep on the bend and continued with a sustained effort to collar CANADIAN LYNX and edge that foe under firm handling to prevail. The latter sped clear of his foes along the inside soon after the start, opened a commanding margin on the turn but couldn't sustain his momentum through the final sixteenth. GOLDEN BULL was settled outside foes in the opening quarter, swung out four deep entering upper stretch and made some belated progress to gain a share. TOQUINHO was reserved just out of striking distance tracking the pacesetter along the inside racing to the bend, made a brief bid in tandem with the eventual winner racing into upper stretch but flattened out in the last quarter. SWEEPY BLUFF broke awkwardly and never gained contention. ASWAAQ was urged along chasing the pacesetter into the bend and gave way after a half.
