Footnotes

BOM BABY broke inwards brushing a rival, was reserved along the rail tracking behind the second flight to the far turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and made steady progress to the end to edge CALLALOO under firm encouragement. The latter, held up just off the leaders along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted three wide to challenge nearing upper stretch, gained brief command while shifting inwards in upper stretch and just failed to contain the winner. SUNLACED broke in the air, was collected to track the leaders three deep to the backstretch, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch to challenge, couldn't match the top pair and just lasted for a share. BELLERIVE broke inwards, was settled along the inside, switched out five wide on the far turn while making some progress and continued willingly in that path to the end. MARGO'S DELIGHT, brushed at the start, was settled along the inside to the far turn, shifted outside some tiring foes racing through the stretch and improved her placing. BELL Z GIRL worked her way to the inside early, saved ground to the far turn, swung out in upper stretch but made no impact. MONA MONA, forwardly placed outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed that foe racing through the far turn and gave way near midstretch. VICKY'S BAR bobbed at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to the lead, dueled for command inside a foe to the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. GAL NAMED LESLIE broke outwards brushing the gate, was reserved along the inside and never gained contention. VAL CAPONI was a brief factor outside a foe in second flight in the opening half and emptied out early.
