Footnotes

FAST PROMISES tracked the leaders unhurried off the second flight along the inside, moved to challenge along the rail entering the turn, shook clear in upper stretch and was kept to a drive. JUDITH'S LAKE, reserved outside foes racing to the turn, made steady progress four wide racing into upper stretch and secured the place late. MILES AND MILES tracked the pacesetter in second flight three deep between foes in the opening half, moved to challenge in that path entering the turn, couldn't match terms with the winner and was outfinished for the place. CRUZATTE went to the lead while under some reserve, dictated the pace near the inside racing to the bend, briefly resisted the winner but gave way in upper stretch. BOSCO RULES settled near the inside and never gained contention. PEDESTAL angled inwards to track the pace between foes but dropped out of contention early. STAR VECTOR, a brief factor in the second flight, dropped out early.
